



PROJECT FOCUS

To improve the content and process associated with Austin Pathways' resident health assessments.

KEY ACTIVITIES & DELIVERABLES

- Evaluated current version of resident health assessments; identified opportunities for improvement
- Collaborated with Austin Pathways Health & Wellness Program Manager and conducted interviews with Austin Pathways' Community Health Workers (CHWs) to better understand their experiences and insights with administering the assessments to residents and gaps in the data currently collected
- Developed a new, condensed version of the health assessments
- Summarized research methodology and findings into a report; developed a Health & Wellness Program slide deck template
